GREAT-OAKS - Located on the Wilberforce camp site, Great Oaks is a modern, permanent building designed to accommodate 30 overnight and for more for daytime activities. There are two dormitories with bunk beds for 14 and 10 and two rooms each with three beds.

A well equipped kitchen with large refrigerators, freezer, gas stove and ample work tops and cupboards. Great Oaks also has electric lighting and gas heating, main drainage toilets, shower, telephone etc.
