

The Russian National Jamboree Regulations
“Symbirian Breeze 2008”

1. Aims:

- to promote intellectual, physical and social development of children and young people;
- to further scout philosophy, methods of scout upbringing and its advantages for the young people;
- to exchange experience between scout organizations;
- to get acquainted with Ulianovsk region (the 65th anniversary of the region), its traditions, history, ethnographic museums in the open air.

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2. Jamboree Organizers:

- The Russian Scout Organization (RSO);
- RSO office in Ulianovsk region “The Association of Scouts”;
- The Administration of Ulianovsk region;
- The Ministry of Youth Development in Ulianovsk region;
- The Ministry of Education in Ulianivsk region;
- The Administration of Melekesskiy district of Ulianovsk region.

3. Place and Dates.

- Dates: th 20th of July - 1st of August 2008
- * The arrival period is open from the 15th of July to prepare the place for living. The departure period is prolonged till the 3d of August.
- Place: Ulianovsk region, Melekesskiy district, Nikolskoe-na-Cheremshan (a village)
- Form: tent camp

4. Jamboree Programme:

The Jamboree Programme is dedicated to the Centenary of Russian Scout Movement. All the components are united by one topic.

The programme includes:

- opening and Crowning ceremonies;
- daily activities;
- sub-programmes: ecological, tourist, sports, games, excursions.

5. Participants:

- scouts aged 8 – 18, headed by grown-up leaders (5+1);
- members of Russian children and youth organizations and unions, aged 8 -18 (organizers' agreement is needed);

- young people older than 18, members of the service staff must have an experience of working in a service staff team, scout life experience, education;
- Guests and people invited by the organizers.
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6. Conditions of participation:

a) To take part in the Jamboree a participant have to:

- pay the participation fee (in accord with *Payment Regulations*) until the 1st of June 2008. The fee includes: participation in the programme, food, a tie, stripe, Jamboree participant record book, badge)
- fill in the necessary documentation (a registration card of a participant, parental permission for children under 18, personal information form)
- have a medical insurance certificate, lung x-ray examination for children older than 15

b) transportation fee of the nominated participant is paid by a nominating organization

c) each group has to possess its own equipment for living in a camp

d) during the Jamboree there will be a so-called *Market* (participants can buy food, gifts, etc)

7. Management Committee:

The preparation to the Jamboree is run by the Management Committee which was submitted by the Administration of Ulianovsk region.

Objectives:

- to submit the Jamboree programme
- to manage the budget
- to coordinate the preparation to the event

8. The Board of Directors

The Board of Directors manages the programme realization, administration and maintenance of the event.

9. Management and Organizational Structures of the Jamboree

a) to manage the Jamboree the board of Directors was formed.

b) the Board of Directors manages cooperation and communication all the units of the Jamboree, the programme realization, administration and maintenance of the event.

- c) The Board of Directors includes:
- d) - the head of IT unit
- e) - the head of PR and info unit
- f) - the head of administrative unit
- g) - the head of technical service unit
- h) - the head of trade unit
- i) - the head of foreign affairs unit
- j) - the heads of villages (monitor), the heads of subcamps

k) On the territory of the Jamboree 4-6 basic villages are formed, 1000 participants in each. The head of the village is responsible for maintenance of his/her village. The villages are divided into subcamps, 200-300 participants in each. The head of each subcamp is responsible for administration and maintenance of his/her subcamp. A separate service team works in each village.

- l) A service team is formed of:
- m) - IT unit workers
- n) - PR and info unit workers
- o) - administrative unit workers
- p) - technical service unit workers
- q) - trade unit workers
- r) - foreign affairs unit workers

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
